- Redirecting play as needed to promote inclusive, safe and positive interactions.
- Inviting parents/guardians and caregivers into play experiences to support in scaffolding and extending play at their child's level of development with the materials provided.
- Working alongside EarlyON Professionals to deliver regular programs effectively.

- Strong communication skills and the ability to work independently within defined parameters.
- Comfort in a loud and busy environment requiring adaptability and problem-solving.
- Physical ability to manage heavy lifting and set up, take down and move play areas, furniture, toys and materials.

- An acceptable Police Vulnerable Sector Check.
- Some sites may require reliable transportation.
